CO-HOPE (Collaborative Housing in a Pandemic Era), is an international research project involving institutions from Sweden, Austria, Finland, France and Spain. Through theoretically informed applied research on collaborative housing, this project aims at generating potential-oriented recommendations for policymakers, and implementing an international capacity building programme on collaborative housing that tackles the affordability-integration-health nexus.

In the course of a two day working session in Vienna, the project team will share some of the insights gained thus far with the local public. **The public event "Resilient Urban Development - Learning from Cooperative Housing Projects"** wants to give you an understanding of the project and first results from it. **A panel discussion involving local experts** will reflect on the merits and potential of collaborative housing projects in the wider context of urban development, as well as highlighting lessons learned and room for improvement.
